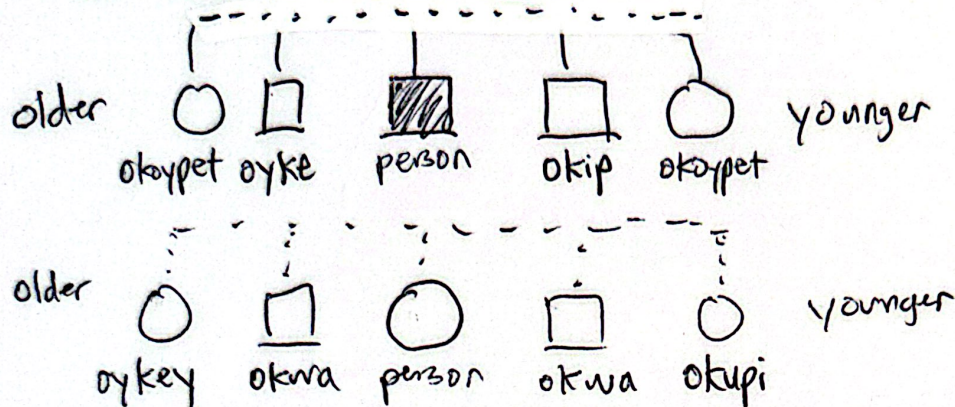

Family terms in Sakurabiat are as follows:

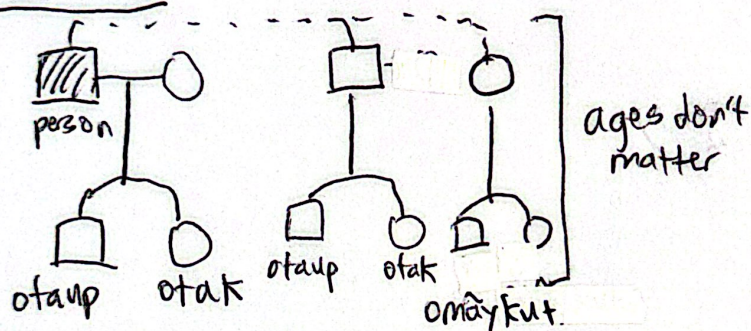

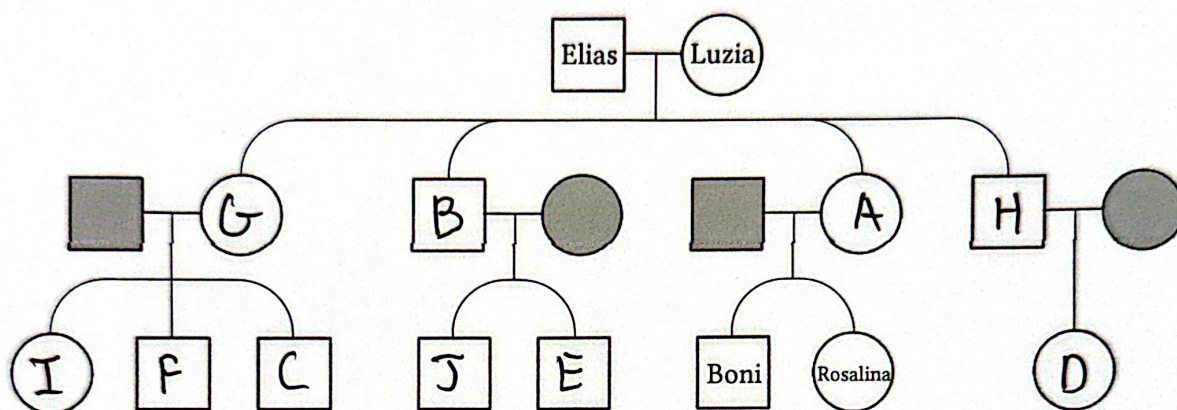
